

Governance and strategies

- Energy Community Treaty
 - United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change
 - Paris Agreement on Climate Change
 - Sofia Declaration on the Green Agenda for the Western Balkans
-
- Integrated Energy and Climate Plan for Bosnia and Herzegovina until 2030 (NECP BiH)
-
- ✓ obligation arising from the Energy Community Treaty
 - ✓ targets for increasing energy efficiency measures, increasing the use of RES and reducing GHG emissions by 2030, as well as the necessary policies and measures to achieve them
 - ✓ first time that BiH applies an integrated approach where the future development of energy is observed in accordance with climate change



Energy sector transition in Bosnia and Herzegovina

- a complex issue and a great challenge that is also an exceptional opportunity for economic development
- will require significant investments in low-carbon technologies and infrastructure

- New Laws on RES in BiH:
 - Prosumers
 - Renewable energy communities
